Dear Chair,

On behalf of President von der Leyen, I would like to thank you and the co-signatories of the presidential Troika for your letter of 1 June 2021 on the interparliamentary work carried out during the Portuguese Presidency.

The Commission welcomes the thorough interparliamentary work of the Conference of Parliamentary Committees for Union Affairs of Parliaments of the European Union (COSAC), to which it could contribute. We commend the Portuguese Presidency for its rich parliamentary dimension and achievements during the challenging first semester of 2021. National Parliaments' input into European policy-making in the context of our political dialogue and of the subsidiarity control mechanism is very important, and they have a central role for linking the citizens and the institutions of the European Union. This is particularly true in the current difficult circumstances, where solidarity is key for overcoming the economic and social crisis linked to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Commission is grateful to the Portuguese Presidency and to national Parliaments who did their utmost to facilitate the swift national approval of the Council Decision on EU Own Resources, which entered into force on 1 June 2021. This allowed the Commission to start borrowing money rapidly on the markets on behalf of the EU. National Parliaments will have an important role to play with respect to the national recovery and resilience plans in the framework of the NextGenerationEU. These are essential for creating a new dynamism in our economies and societies.
